Hello,

We're writing to let you know that a Registered Disability Savings Plan (RDSP) has been established at Mackenzie Investments on your behalf. This plan was opened by **<<Holder Name>>,** who is recognized as a "Qualifying Family Member."

The *Income Tax Act* allows an adult RSDP beneficiary's "Qualifying Family Member" to be the holder of the RDSP without requiring a formal order of financial guardianship. This is a temporary provision, in place until December 31, 2023. The account holder/qualifying family member must consent to any transactions that occur in the plan.

A "Qualifying Family Member" is an individual who is a:

- Legal parent; or
- Spouse or common-law partner who is not living separate and apart from you because of a breakdown of your marriage or common-law partnership.

Replacing an account holder of an RDSP:

- 1) You can become the current holder of the plan if:
 - You are determined to be contractually competent by a competent tribunal or other authority under the laws of a province, or in Mackenzie's opinion after reasonable inquiry, your contractual competence to enter into a disability savings plan is no longer in doubt, and
 - You notify Mackenzie Investments that you will become the holder of the plan.
- 2) If someone is appointed as the guardian, tutor, or curator to be legally authorized to act on your behalf, then the legal representative will replace the current account holder of the plan by notifying Mackenzie Investments without delay following his or her appointment.
